Veterinary Services:

Preventative and Wellness Care:

- Knoxville Animal Clinic strives to provide the best routine care, and illness prevention, for all of our canine and feline patients. Don't wait until your pet is sick to come in!
- It is important to schedule yearly annual comprehensive physical exams, vaccinations, parasite checks, and heartworm testing & tick borne disease screening. During your pet's visit we will discuss and provide information regarding the importance of monthly heartworm prevention, flea and tick prevention, and the importance of routine blood screening, to ensure you have a healthy canine or feline.

Geriatric Care:

- Canine and feline patients are considered geriatric around age 7 and we want to ensure your animal is healthy and active as they get older.
- In addition to yearly examinations, vaccinations, parasite checks, and heartworm testing, we encourage yearly blood testing (complete blood count, chemistry panel, thyroid level check, and urinalysis) for all of our geriatric patients.

Dental Care:

- Did you know it is important to schedule a yearly dental for your pet? Regular professional cleaning is important to maintaining your pet's teeth and overall health.
- Knoxville Animal Clinic uses ultrasonic scaling to clean and polish each of our dental prophylaxis. Schedule an appointment for a dental health check to learn more about routine dental health care for your pet.

Internal Medicine:

- We routinely see patients with various chronic medical conditions such as Diabetes, Cushing's disease, hypothyroidism hyperthyroidism, heart disease, and renal disease. However, certain internal medicine cases require expertise in cardiology, ophthalmology, neurology, dermatology, oncology, internal medicine, and surgery. Our veterinarians maintain a relationship with local board certified veterinarians for cases needing referrals or additional diagnostics to ensure your pet is receiving the best care.

General Surgery:

- All patients are carefully pre-screened to determine the safest anesthetic and surgical protocol specifically for each animal. Surgical consultations available for orthopedic and certain soft tissue procedures.
- Common surgical procedures performed include soft tissue surgery such as mass removals, spay and neuter services along with dental prophylaxis and extractions.

Nutritional Counseling:

- Some cats and dogs require special diets. Providing the right diet can help prevent disease and encourage weight management.
- Our staff and veterinarians will be able to help you choose the right diet for your pet to keep them happy, healthy, and active. There are a variety of canine and feline prescription diets available for purchase at the clinic including Hill's Science Diet, Royal Canin, and Purina.

Boarding and Grooming Services:

Bathing:

- Treat your pet to a luxurious bath to help remove dirt and pet odor!
- Nail trimming, ear cleaning, and anal gland expression are including in grooming services.

Grooming:

- Our highly trained groomer, Jenny Warren, is here to meet all your grooming needs, including special hair cutting, shaving, and bathing.
- If itching or scratching is a problem, we offer medicated bathing to help soothe your itchy pet.

Dog and Cat Boarding:

- Pets are family and each of our boarding animals receive special attention, whether it be extra outside play time, extra cuddle time, or leash walking, our kennel staff will provide tender loving care to your canine or feline.
- Our canine guests receive up to three supervised outdoor play sessions per day for activity.
- We do not charge for routine medication administration, however, there is a \$10 fee insulin administration fee for diabetic patients (the fee may be adjusted based on length of stay).
- For security purposes, we do not allow after hours or Sunday pick up.
